Karnataka Rajya Bennuhuri Apagatada Angavikalara Sanga (KRBAAS) is a non-profit organization established in 2008 by people affected with Spinal Cord injury. Primary focus of KRBAAS is to support person affected with spinal cord injury. It is one of the four organizations in Karnataka that works in the area of spinal cord injury. KRBAAS has the expertise and experience in providing inhouse rehabilitation using specially designed equipment. KRBAAS is located in Magadi, Ramanagara district and is currently working in 5 districts of Karnataka – Ramanagara, Mandya, Mysuru, Hassan, and Chamarajanagara.

MISSION:

VISION:

In Karnataka PWSCI's (Persons with spinal cord Injury) will lead a dignified, healthy and Independent life.

In order to support the persons with spinal cord injury (PWSCI) KRBAAS does the following intervention at two levels:

- 1. **Social Rehabilitation Centre (SRC-Institution)**: Established in the year 2012, a total of 170 beneficiaries were provided with the following services.
 - a. Medical assessment and Physiotherapy
 - b. Individual and Family counselling.
 - c. Develop the Activities of daily living skills (ADLS)
 - d. Management of Primary and Secondary complications.
 - e. Provide suitable mobility Aids.
 - f. Livelihood training.
- 2. **Community based Rehabilitation Centre (CBR)**: Initiated in the year 2010, a total of 1050 beneficiaries have been reached under this program. Major activities carried out are:
 - a. Identification of beneficiaries and conducting assessment
 - b. Referring to SRC if needed
 - c. Regular home visits to PWSCI for supporting them with Government schemes, providing medical aid for bedsores
 - d. Follow up of beneficiaries
 - e. Organize awareness camps and medical intervention camps
 - f. Conducting sensitization trainings for students, NGOs, Integrated Child Development Scheme (ICDS) workers and workers
 - g. Building PWSCI friendly toilets



h. Advocacy with government for rights of PWSCI

Activates Details:

1. New Persons Identification and assessment:

In 2018-2019 year are identified total 140 Persons with Spinal cord Injuries in community Level most of the persons were identified by our field workers within our geography like-Ramanagara, Mandya, Mysore and Haasan districts through the Home visits and Hospital Visits. Once we identified the persons then we take second step its Assessment it's based on ASIA (American Spinal Cord Injury Association) Assessment form with basic needs of the Persons. And also, all 140 are undergone the Assessment.

2. Follow up and Membership:

After the Identification and Assessment than KRBAAS started Follow up with these persons, with the main objects like to create independent life within their circle. In this year total 356 PWSCI's are comes under follow up support, majorly follow ups done through Community Based Rehabilitation Program with Home Visits and Hospital Visits. In Community based Rehabilitation KRBAAS gave information about Social security schemes, bed sore management skill, 3% Grama Panchayath fund utilization. Etc...before we gave service to persons, we offer to get membership of Association.

3. Capacity Building Program/ Awareness training:



Capacity Building Training programs / training are nothing but Awareness trainings. This training includes various stake holders in Community level. E.g.- MRW's, VRW's, ICDS workers, ASHA workers, PWSCI's, Care givers and other NGO staff's. In trainings we gave information about what is the Spinal cord injury? what are all the cause for spinal cord injury, Levels of spinal cord injury, what are all the primary and secondary problems, mobility and aids management, balder and bowel maintenance, Social security scheme for PWSCIs, bed sore management skills and also gave information about Social Rehabilitation Center.

In 2018-19 total 448 different stakeholders covered under capacity building training.

4. Mobility Aids Support:

Mobility Aids is the Major Aspect to improve the situation of the Persons with Spinal Cord Injuries, KRBAAS ensured Mobility Aids to PWSCI's in Institutional level and Community level. In this Mobility Aids mainly KAFO, AFO, Wheel Chair, Walker and Elbow crutches.

In this total 136 Mobility Aids Distributed by KRBAAS.

5. Medical kit distribution:



KRBAAS works in Community level with the objective of Medical Intervention and Social Intervention; in Medical intervention KRBAAS distributed the Medical kits in Community through our field workers. In this year total 186 Medical Kits Distributed by KRBAAS and Its Advocacy effort.







6. CADIC camps (Community Aided Disabled intervention camp)

(Medical Intervention Camp, Therapy camp and Yoga camp)

CADIC camps were done in the various places of our Geography like- Mandya, Mysore, Hassan and Ramanagara Dist. In these camps community was made aware of SCI, capacity of PWSCI's and Care givers was build to Prevent secondary complications and enable the Management of PWSCI's. Social Services Security Schemes (SSS) available from the Govt. also we share.

In this 2018-19 year 7 camps conducted by KRBAAS and covered 151 Beneficiaries and parents. Camps done by the Support/collaborated with some Local Organizations and Local Hospitals.
