Ensuring a dignified and active life for people with spinal cord injuries

Established in 2008, KRBAAS is a leading NGO in Karnataka for the rehabilitation of people with spinal cord injuries (PWSCI).

The NGO was established by a group of PWSCIs in Magadi, who saw the lack of support facilities and awareness about the condition in rural areas.

As one of the only four organizations in Karnataka working in the area of spinal cord injury, KRBAAS focuses on providing medical, mobility and activity support to PWSCIs. For the severely affected, we provide in-house rehabilitation care, while for several others we provide community-level support across five districts in the State.

Our beneficiaries are mostly young men from economically challenged backgrounds, who suffer from spinal cord injury while working in unsafe conditions or from road accidents. Since most of them become wheel-chaired for life, we try to restore their health, independence and dignity in the best possible way through our many initiatives.

OUR APPROACH

In order to provide holistic support to PWSCIs, KRBAAS offers critical intervention at two levels – in-house rehabilitation support through the Social Rehabilitation Centre (SRC) and community level outreach through Community Based Rehabilitation (CBR).



Social Rehabilitation Centre

The Social Rehabilitation Centre was set up in 2012 to provide medical and counselling support to severely affected PWSCIs from across Karnataka. Located in Magadi village, our SRC centre has specially designed equipment, physiotherapists and counsellors, part from residential facilities for the beneficiaries.

SRC provides the following services to PWSCIs:

- · Medical assessment and physiotherapy
- · Individual and family counselling
- Developing the activities of daily living skills (ADLS)
- · Management of primary and secondary complications
- Suitable mobility aids, including wheelchairs
- · Livelihood training

Community Based Rehabilitation

Initiated in the year 2010, CBR is conducted by the outreach team of KRBAAS, who identify and assess PWSCIs in need of support across various rural districts. The beneficiaries then receive ongoing medical, counselling and rehabilitation support, right at their doorstep.

The CBR activities across Karnataka include,

- Identification and assessment of beneficiaries with the help of local healthcare centres, Anganwadis and ASHA workers
- Regular home visits and follow-ups to provide medical treatment for bedsores, counselling, informing them about government schemes, etc.
- Organizing awareness camps and medical intervention camps in villages
- Conducting sensitization training to local healthcare providers, NGOs, ICDS workers, etc.
- Building PWSCI-friendly toilets in beneficiary homes
- Referring beneficiary to SRC if further support is needed
- · Advocacy for PWSCI rights with the State government
